# EYFS - Spring Term Curriculum Map



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## **Communication and Language**

We will be practising our listening and attentions skills during carpet sessions. We will be active listeners and become more effective at feeding back what our partner has communicated. We will learn specialised vocabulary about our topic.

## **Personal, Social and Emotional Development**

Our topic this term is, Our Wonderful World. We will learn about what makes our local area, Birstall, special to us. We will learn to work in teams as we create large scale maps.

## **Physical Development**

In PE we will be exploring the skills of cooperation and control as we work in teams and refine our gross motor skills.

We will also explore dance movements and practise a sequence of movements.

## **Literacy**

We will continue using Little Wandle as the children begin learning their Phase 3 sounds that consist of digraphs and trigraphs. Children will practise applying their phonic skills during their thrice weekly reading sessions and independent writing opportunities.

## **Maths**

In Maths, we will be embedding our understanding of the composition of numbers by composing and decomposing numbers. We will learn to do these using objects and then through mental strategies. The children will learn to recall number facts quickly using the part part whole method.

## **Understanding the World**

We will begin by learning about our local area and use this as a starting point to make comparisons with other areas in the UK. Children will also learn about other countries and think about the natural vegetation and animals that thrive in these habitats.

## **Expressive Arts and Design**

We will use songs to develop our understanding of our topic and for children to express their creativity in movement. The children will also use their creativity and teamwork skills to construct houses out of junk modelling as we explore the subtopic of homes.
